

**RESOLUTION NO. 2005-18**

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF OCEAN RIDGE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND TOWN CLERK TO EXECUTE AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN PALM BEACH COUNTY (PBcty) AND THE TOWN OF OCEAN RIDGE TO REPLACE THE INTEROPERABILITY INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT THROUGH THE USE OF THE COUNTYWIDE 800 MHZ TRUNKED RADIO SYSTEM WITH A NEW DIRECT ACCESS AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, the County and Town are continually identifying more effective service delivery methods which result in overall savings to the taxpayers of the County and the Town; and

WHEREAS, the County has purchased, designed, installed, and operates an 800 MHz Trunked Radio System that supports the needs of the PBcty Sheriff's Office, Fire Rescue, Medical Services, and various Palm Beach County general government agencies; and

WHEREAS, the County and Town have determined that the ability to provide interoperable communications is critical to the effective and efficient provision of public safety and general government services; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined to be mutually beneficial to both Parties to execute this Agreement which sets forth the parameters under which the Town can directly access the County's Radio System saving the taxpayers money of both the County and the Town as well as the opportunity to receive the public safety benefit of interoperability.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF OCEAN RIDGE, FLORIDA THAT:

Section 1. The Interlocal Agreement along with the attachments attached hereto as Exhibit "A", by and between the Town of Ocean Ridge and PBcty as enumerated herein is hereby approved and adopted by the Town Commission, and the Mayor and Town Clerk are directed to execute the agreement, and forthwith forward the same to Nancy Dolan, Business and Community Agreements Manager, Facilities Development & Operations for PBcty.
