COVID-19 Update #22 April 30, 2020 at 11:00 AM

On April 29th Governor DeSantis held a press conference outlining his newest Executive Order, Number 20-112, which outlines the first phase of limited re-openings in the state. This order specifically excludes Palm Beach, Broward and Miami-Dade counties. This means that:

1. All beaches and beach parks remain closed at this time in Palm Beach County.
2. Senior citizens and individuals with underlying medical conditions are strongly encouraged to stay at home and take all measures to limit the risk of exposure to COVID-19.
3. Groups of greater than 10 continue to be prohibited in public without proper social distancing.
4. All non-essential travel should continue to be avoided.
5. Restaurants may continue to offer limited take-out and delivery services.
6. Gyms, fitness centers, bars, pubs and night clubs remain closed.
7. The prohibition on vacation rentals remains in effect statewide, including Palm Beach County.
8. Elective medical procedures under certain circumstances will now be allowed statewide, including Palm Beach County.

While we know everyone is anxious to get back to normal, our goal continues to be the safety of our residents. We are working with County Officials on safe procedures for easing restrictions in other areas as quickly as it is safe to do so. We thank you for your patience as we work through these delicate procedures.

Social distancing continues to be extremely important, and facial coverings continue to be strongly urged while in public places. We ask residents to remain vigilant in helping to keep our community safe.
